# **DON'T GET SKIMMED THIS HOLIDAY**

The best defense is a good offense! And the best way to protect yourself against skimmers is to know how to spot them. All you need to remember is SCAN!

- **S:** Scan your surroundings. Look to see if there's anything out of place.
- **C:** Check for any tampering. Are the panels dented or broken?
- A: Assess the card reader. The colors should match and no graphics should be misaligned or cut-off.
- N: Nudge the keypad. Most skimmers are made to be temporary, so they usually can come loose.

### **Cookie Recipe Ingredients:**

1 C. Butter

1 C. Granulated Sugar

1 tsp. Vanilla

1 Large Egg

2 tsp. Baking Powder

3 C. All-Purpose Flour

### **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Preheat oven to 350° F.
- 2. In a medium bowl, combine baking powder with flour and set aside.
- 3. In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar for 3 minutes or until smooth.
- 4. Add in the egg and vanilla, beating until blended.
- 5. Slowly add in flour mixture a little at a time while slowly beating. The dough will be stiff. Finish kneading by hand if necessary.
- Divide dough and roll one portion on floured surface to ¼ inch thickness.
   Dough must be room temperature to roll.
   Cut cookies.
- 7. Place on cookie sheet and bake for 6-8 minutes.
- B. Let cool on the cookie sheet until firm enough to transfer to a cooling rack.
- 9. Ice cookies when cool.

### Icing Recipe Ingredients:

2 C. Powdered Sugar

1 ½ tsp. Corn Syrup

2 tsp. Canola Oil

3 Tbsp. Hot Water

Food Coloring

### **DIRECTIONS:**

- 1. Combine all ingredients in bowl and beat until smooth.
- 2. Divide icing into separate bowls and add food coloring.
- 3. To thin icing, add more water a few drops at a time to get desired consistency.
- 4. To thicken icing, add more powdered sugar to get desired consistency.
- 5. Spread thin icing on cookies with small spatula. Pipe thicker icing for finer details.
- 6. Let icing harden and enjoy!

# Your Quick Guide on How to Create a Holiday Budget
